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Your dog ownership will be a richer and more rewarding experience if you enter into it with realistic expectations. Please review the following facts:

- Goldendoodles/Doubledoodles/Labradoodles are not maintenance-free dogs. They require weekly brushing to avoid matting. Brushing will be even more important, and perhaps frequent, between the 6-month to 24-month age, while the puppy coat transitions to an adult coat.
- You will need to clean your doodle's ears twice a month.
- Professional grooming will be necessary 3-4 times a year depending on the look you prefer.
- Young puppies normally nip, especially at young children. It will take effort and discipline on your part to manage this.
- Your puppy will be physiologically capable of being 100% housebroken at 7-8 months of age; many puppies are reliable much earlier.
